Key Stage Three

- Students will follow learning programmes in English, Maths and Science. The curriculum will be delivered so it ensures that any legacy of previous underachievement in literacy and numeracy is addressed.
- Students will also have access to Sports, Computing, Music, Religious Education, History, Geography, French, Spanish, Art and Technology. These are delivered as discrete subjects across the weekly timetable. A small group of students in year 7 and 8 will follow a more personalised pathway in order for them to rapidly develop their Literacy and Numeracy skills and prepare them for future studies.

Key Stage Four

All students have the standard Maths, English, Science and PE statutory requirements in Key stage 4.

- A full complement of GCSEs and BTEC course are offered across the key stage.
- All students will begin GCSE and other level 1 & 2 courses in Year 9 which end in Year 11.

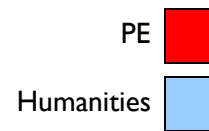
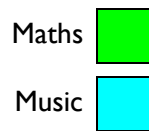
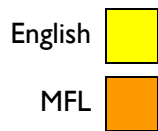
